



TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF NOMINATION AND PARTICIPATION

1. This project is an initiative of the Youth Entrepreneurship Campaign 2010 (YEC) in partnership with Sowetan and Sunday World.
2. The Future 100 project is open to any South African citizen between the ages of 16 and 36, and who owns (minimum 25% ownership) and operates a business enterprise.
3. The enterprise may be a formal or informal enterprise, ie a company, close corporation, co-operative, stokvel, partnership or sole proprietor business.
4. Any person, including employees, partners and family members of a nominee, may nominate an entrepreneur.
5. The nominee consents to being nominated as an entrant in the Future 100 project.
6. The nominator and nominee confirm that all information contained in the nomination form is true and correct, and agree that the provision of incomplete, untrue or incorrect information may result in the nomination being disqualified without notice being given.
7. Nominations may be submitted by e-mail, post, on the YEC website and by fax to the addresses specified on the website and on this nomination form.
8. In order to be considered for adjudication, nominations must be submitted no later than 5pm on 30 September 2008, or such other date as YEC may specify.
9. The decision of the judges will be final. The YEC shall not be obliged to give reasons for its decisions and the personal and business information submitted to YEC, to be used and published for promotional and publicity purposes without prior notice or remuneration.
10. Nominees selected as one of the Future 100 entrepreneurs for 2008 will be notified by e-mail or post.
11. YEC reserve the right to change and alter the terms and conditions of the Future 100 competition at any time without notice.
12. YEC make no guarantee or warranty that the nominator or nominee will derive any commercial or business benefit from the project.
